Bob hails from Nepal and Debbie from the United States. In 1991 the Adhikarys moved to Bob's grandfather's village house in southern Nepal and started sharing the gospel with people who had never heard about Jesus Christ. Their first Christian converts were from a people group who spoke a Maithali dialect. They were known for being staunch Hindus and so persecution of new Christians became the norm. After training pastors and establishing 5 churches among the Maithali, the Adhikarys began to reach out and establish churches among the Nepalese speaking population. Today, they have over 120 pastors and evangelists who minister in 43 churches, the bulk of which are in areas of Nepal that border India, with 4 churches in India itself. In 2011, the Adhikarys established New Leaf, a home for abused girls. God has blessed each of their endeavors over the years, but the Adhikarys are quick to acknowledge, as John Bradford once stated, 'There but for the grace of God go I!'
