We lived there and restored this lovely home which was built in 1562 by Urian Brereton for Margaret Honford. There is a great connection to St, Mary's Church, Cheadle where I was married, my parents were married and my children were christened. The Honford Star can be seen today in the stained glass window at the altar of St. Mary's.

My two children attended Handforth Village School and St. Chad's Sunday School, I was also confirmed at St. Chad's during the 70's by the then Vicar Alan Smith who coincidentally had been the Curate at St. Mary's previously.

After restoring Handforth Hall we moved to South Florida U.S.A for five years and I then eventually moved to Pheonix, Arizona for two years returning to the UK in the late 80's.

I moved to Wilmslow 11 years ago, and became a committed Christian three years ago. I feel I have done a full circle with God as my guide nudging me back home to St. Chad's where I now help with the office admin, the crèche and the flower team.

My past life has been very colourful but sadly fractured and not always happy.

I am now so blessed with my family, four grandchildren, three in Wilmslow with my daughter and son-in-law and one in Connecticut U.S.A . with my son and daughter-in-law.

Finally in my late 60's I have perfect peace and joy since I opened my heart to our Lord who has rescued me and given me his promise of life in all it's fullness.

# Capernwray Bible School visit

Here at St Chad's, we will soon be hosting some students from Capernwray Bible school in Carnforth, as part of their programme of enrichment in the Christian life experience and study. Below is some information from their website.

'Our desire at Capernwray Bible School is to provide an environment where people of all ages can discover, develop or re-ignite a living relationship with the Lord Jesus. We know that this relationship is the only true foundation for life and our desire is that people understand and experience this reality and have their lives changed forever. Consequently, former students from all over the world say that the time they spent at Capernwray was the most transforming time of their Christian life.

We also believe that practical application is a vital element of Christian life. Therefore we provide a wide range of outreach activities that will take place throughout the course. We are confident that what we enable the students to learn and practice at Capernwray will equip them in serving
